





SOFIDEL HOSTS IN LUCCA THE 2nd EDITION OF THE ITALIAN BUSINESS & SDGs ANNUAL FORUM OF THE GLOBAL COMPACT NETWORK ITALY FOUNDATION

More than 100 businesses and organisations gathered to promote the Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations 2030 Agenda.

The second edition of the **Italian Business & SDGs Annual Forum** has been held in Lucca today. This event has been promoted by the **Global Compact Network Italy Foundation** (GCNI Foundation) in **collaboration with Sofidel**, the tissue production group known for the Regina brand and one of the founding and promoting members of the Foundation.

The Forum aims to give a boost in Italy to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development from the United Nations, and has brought together more than 100 representatives including big companies, SMEs, organisations in civil society, Institutions, Universities and research bodies.
