As for climate, Sofidel achieved an **A- score**, positioning itself **above the European average** (C) **and in line** with the industry average (A-).

Sofidel was also included in the CDP's Supplier Engagement Assessment (SEA) A-list which recognizes companies for their efforts in addressing climate change within their supply chains.
